1. 5 runner beans
2. 5 french (dwarf) beans, any colour
3. 5 medium tomatoes with calyx, around 60 mm diameter
4. 5 small fruited cherry or plum tomatoes with calyx
5. 2 courgettes, 10cm – 15cm long
6. 3 beetroot as grown
7. 3 carrots as grown
8. 3 onions dressed – 250g max
9. 3 onions as grown
- 10.1 cabbage, green or red
- 11.1 edible squash or other cucurbit
- 12.3 medium sized potatoes, e.g. each 175 – 225gm
13. An exhibit of a vegetable not listed
14. A collection of different vegetables to be displayed within the A3 black base provided
15. Heaviest pumpkin
- 16.3 leeks as grown
17. An amusingly shaped vegetable, as grown
- 18.1 cucumber, outdoor or under protection
- 19.2 sweet peppers or 6 chilli peppers
- 20.1 sweet corn, silks attached, section of husk pulled down to reveal grains
- 21.3 dessert apples
- 22.3 cooking apples
23. A plate of berries e.g. raspberries, blackberries

38. A” chocolate tart” with homemade shortcrust pastry base with a ganache filling
39. 3 Scotch eggs meat or vegetarian baked or fried
40. A jar of traditional cooked chutney
